General Rules

Members of Nelson Mountain Bike Club are expected to abide by these general rules:

- Our [code of conduct](#) must be observed at all times.
- Members must not take part in any illegal trail building activity.
- Traffic laws and road rules must be observed at all times.
- Abide by any trail closures and forestry closures.
- Be able to show a valid forestry permit when riding in permitted areas (Ngati Koata land). (To determine which areas require a permit, please check our [website](#).)
- Abide by the [Tasman Pine Forests Limited Forest Rules](#) for permit holders when riding in permitted areas.
- All Members must promote the interests and the objects of the Club and must do nothing to bring the Club into disrepute.

Indemnity

- I understand the risks, dangers and hazards associated with mountain biking and understand that injuries are a common part of mountain biking. I acknowledge that mountain biking is an inherently dangerous sport and I participate at my own risk. I freely accept and fully assume such risks.

Acceptance

- I warrant that the details set out in the Application for Membership are true and correct. If they change, I acknowledge that I am required to notify the Nelson Mountain Bike Club of the changes, in writing, as soon as possible after they occur.
- I agree to my details and those of my family (if a Family membership is being applied for) being provided to MTBNZ and Cycling NZ for the purposes of statistical collection as per the club's [Privacy Statement](#).
- I agree to abide by the [Club Rules](#) and that any Committee decision is final
