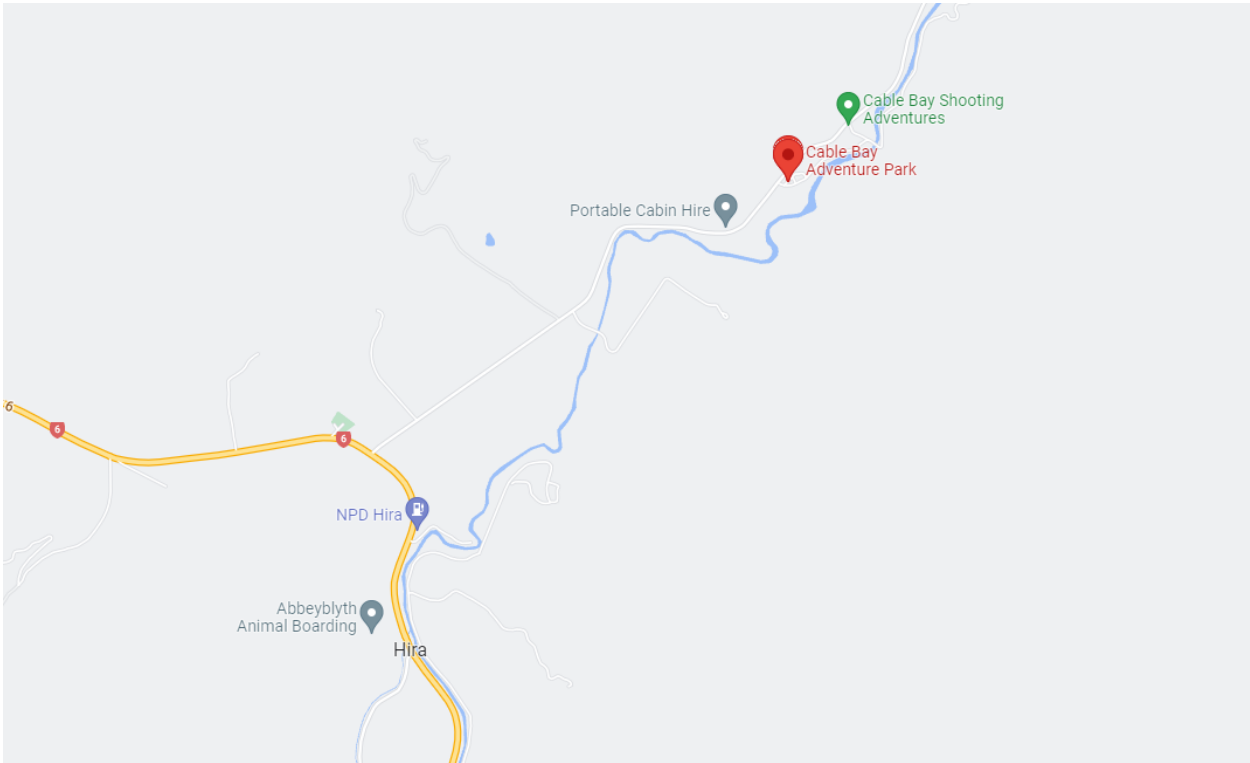

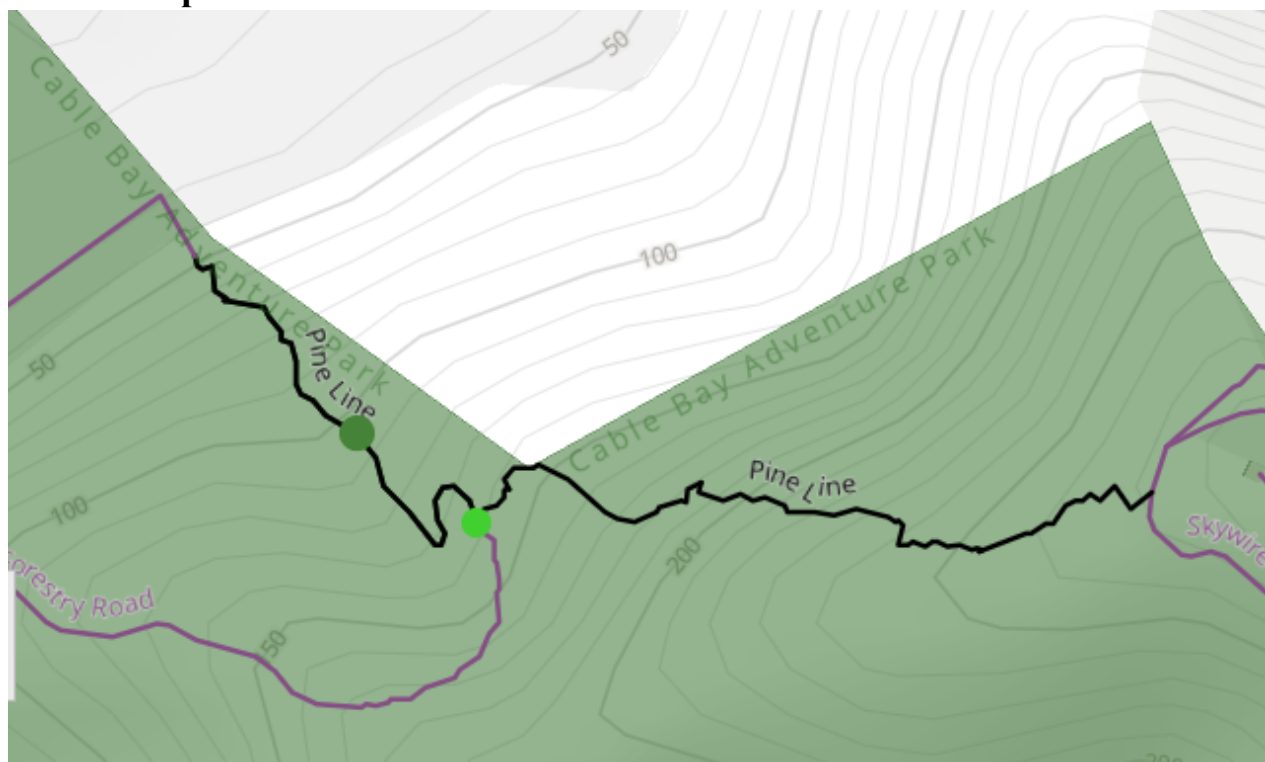
Entrants can be a member of any NZ cycling club.

Rules and Equipment:

U17 & U15

All entrants must wear Knee protection, Neck Brace and a Full face helmet.

(Enduro Style' 2 Piece helmets with removable Chin-bar are permitted if they meet the approved Safety Certification below. Must achieve one of the following approved Safety Certification standards: ASTM-F1952 (ASTM for DH), UN/ECE Reg No. 22, AS 1698, NZ5430, British standard BS 6658 or Japanese standard T8133).

Entrants without these compulsory items will not be allowed to ride. Full finger gloves, Elbow pads and Long sleeves (no singlets) are encouraged.

All other categories

All entrants must wear Knee protection and a Full face helmet *(Enduro Style' 2 Piece helmets with removable Chin-bar are permitted if they meet the approved Safety Certification below. Must achieve one of the following approved Safety Certification standards: ASTM-F1952 (ASTM for DH), UN/ECE Reg No. 22, AS 1698, NZ5430, British standard BS 6658 or Japanese standard T8133).*

Medical Provisions:
